

Acer rubrum 'Bowhall' 'Bowhall' Red Maple

Zone: 4

Height: 40'

As you can see above, Acer Bowhall is a glorious pillar of fire in fall. It's a tree that doesn't take up a lot of horizontal space in today's smaller lots. It's also great as a street tree. It takes most soils, wet or dry, except alkaline soil. Once established, it withstands drought. This tree was difficult to find a few years ago, but because of tissue culture, it is now more available. We offer Bowhall in several sizes of whips and branched. Growers should take care to train the young Bowhall. It has a tendency to have very tight crotch angle. If allowed to pass, these may cause trouble later on.
