

Acer tataricum - Tataricum Maple

Zone: 3-7

Height: To 25'

Width: To 20'



Exposure: Full sun
Crown: Oval to round
Growth: Slow to medium
Soil: Sandy to clay
pH: Neutral to alkaline
Drainage: Good drainage preferred
Drought: Extremely tolerant once established
Salt: Some tolerance
Breakage: Strong
Pests: Few if any
Disease: Susceptible to Verticillium wilt

These seedling grown *Acer tartaricum* are quite variable as to size, form, samara color and fall color. Tartarian Maple generally prefers to be a multi-stem tree, but can be trained into a single leader form. This tree is urban tough, so construction soils are ok. Samaras are up to 1" and vary in color from tan to rosy red and are visible from mid summer to fall. Fall color varies from yellow to red.

It also has exfoliating bark.
