

## Acer triflorum - Three flowered maple

Zone: 4-9

Height: 20'-30'

Width: 20'-30'

Exposure: Sun, part shade  
Crown: Upright in shade, round in sun  
Growth: Slow to moderate  
Soil: Moist well drained, but not wet  
pH: Neutral to acid  
Drainage: Good drainage  
Drought: Very tolerant once established  
Pests: Few  
Disease: Susceptible to verticillium wilt



The two main features of this tree are its defoliating bark and fall color. The bark is light brown to cinnamon and defoliates in plates rather than the paper like bark of *Acer griseum*. The fall color includes gold, orange, red, scarlet and purple. The flowers are probably small and not ornamental.
