'Walker' Weeping Pea Shrub

Zone: 2b-8a

Height: 8'

Width: 10'

Crown: Weeping

'Walker' Weeping Pea shrub does best in drier conditions, and prefers more of an alkaline soil. It also withstands very cold temperatures, as well as wind and drought. It should do very well in the Mountain States. It works well either as a patio container plant or a specimen in the yard. The spring flowers are yellow. The pea like fruit is first yellow, then green and finally black. The leaves of 'Walker' are very thin and fine textured, almost feathery. Robinson Nursery offers 'Walker' Weeping Pea Shrub grafted on a 42" bare root standard. It transplants very well.
