

## **Celtis occidentalis 'Chicagoland' - Chicagoland Hackberry**

Zone: 3b-9b

Height: 50'

Width: 40'



Exposure: Full sun  
Crown: Broadly oval  
Growth: Medium  
Soil: Sandy loam to clay loam  
pH: Acid to alkaline  
Drainage: Occasional wet soils  
Drought: Very tolerant once established  
Salt: Some tolerance  
Breakage: Slight breakage  
Pests: Few  
Disease: Few

Chicagoland Hackberry has a strong central leader, which makes it a boon for growers. It is an urban tough plant, tolerating salt, pollution, poor soils, drought and insects and disease. This is a tree that will grow well in a bad site. Fall color is yellow, and summer foliage is light green.
