Introduced by Handy Nursery in Portland, 'Radiant Rose' Dogwood has probably the most reliable pink flower of all the Kousas. Bloom time is usually two to three weeks in May/June. This tree is consistent, year after year for a dazzling show of bright pink. Foliage for this tree is dark green, turning to orange/red in the fall. Also in the fall are red strawberry sized fruit. Kousa varieties are very resistant to the diseases that trouble *Cornus florida* varieties. Insects are not a problem, at least in the Northwest. Robinson Nursery offers 'Radiant Rose' as branched trees.
