

## Malus Weeping Tina - Weeping Tina Crabapple

Zone: 4

Height: 6'

Width: 8'



Exposure: Full sun  
Form and Crown: Weeping  
Growth Rate: Moderate  
Preferred pH: Varied  
Drought Tolerance: Tolerant once established  
Drainage: Requires good drainage  
Preferred Soil: Loamy  
Insect Pest: Few if any



'Weeping Tina' is a dwarf apple which we graft on a 42" standard. The rootstock is 'SproutFree'® apple, so suckers will never be a problem. This dwarf weeping form of Sargent Tina has red buds which open to pink-white flowers. Red fruit follows. The foliage is a particularly bright shiny green, and very clean looking. This tree is very disease resistant.
