

## Rosa florabunda

## 'NearlyWild' Rose

Zone: 4-9

Height: 3'

Width: 3'

Crown: Rounded mound  
Growth: Moderate  
Soil: Loam, sand  
pH: Acid  
Drought: Tolerant  
Drainage: Well drained  
Breakage: Resistant



While 'Nearly Wild' is a carefree, tough rose, it will perform much better in optimum conditions. Plant in a deeply mulched well drained loamy soil. Don't over or under water, don't over fertilize. Nearly Wild is not bothered by disease, but is by insects. Having the plant in a high state of health will discourage these beasts and also give you an excellent bloom. As you can see, this is a great flower. It blooms 3" single pink fragrant flowers from May to frost. You can increase the amount of bloom by dead-heading a couple of times in the summer.
