

Syringa meyeri 'Palibin'

Dwarf Korean Lilac

Zone: 4-8

Height: 4'-6'

Width: 5'

Crown: Round, oval

Growth: Slow

Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Acid

Here is a nice little lilac with lavender/white to violet/purple flowers in late May to early June. The plants bloom profusely at a young age and the blooms are fragrant. Best flowering is in full sun. This plant is very urban tough, tolerant of drought, pollution and compacted soils. In the worst conditions the foliage holds its dark green shiny condition. There are also no pests or disease, not even Powdery Mildew.

'Palibin' is more dense than the species, and adapts very well to shearing. Flower buds are found throughout the bush, so even when sheared there will still be bloom.
