

Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Shasta' Viburnum

Zone: 5-7

Height: 7'

Width: 11'

Crown: Spreading

Growth: Vigorous

Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Adaptable

Drainage: Well drained



'Shasta' is a not so tall, spreading Viburnum with 4" - 6" flowers, larger than most other selections.

Introduced by the National Arboretum, 'Shasta's' foliage is very dark green and sets off the white blooms quite nicely. In late July, red fruit appears and is soon removed by birds. Fall leaf color is a purple/red turning to maroon. In bloom, this is an extremely beautiful plant. In warmer areas, afternoon shade may be needed.
