

## Zelkova serrata 'Green Veil'

## Pendant Japanese Zelkova

Zone: 5

Height: 50'-60'

Width: 20'-30'

Crown: Upright narrow vase with arching branches

Growth: Moderate

Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Slight acid or alkaline

Drought: Very tolerant



Fairly new to the trade, Zelkova 'Green Veil' is becoming more and more used; introduced by Brookside Gardens. It is a very graceful tree, having an upright form with arching branches. Growing requirements are the same as other Zelkova serrata. Less pruning may be required Spring begins with bright green new foliage, which in fall turns to copper, orange yellow or red. Flowers are inconspicuous. Zelkovas are generally resistant to Dutch Elm Disease and Elm Leaf Beetles. It can be subject to canker diseases. Avoid wounding the trunk, as the wound serves as an entry point for fungus and bacteria.
