

## Fothergilla gardenii

## Dwarf Fothergilla

Zone: 4-8

Height: 5'

Width: 5'

Crown: Rounded  
Growth Rate: Slow  
Soil: Loamy, organic  
Drainage: Well drained, but moist  
pH: Acidic  
Drought: Not tolerant  
Pests: Few if any



This shrub is covered with soft, white bottle brush type blooms in spring before leaves appear. Then in fall, leaves turn a bright red, orange and yellow before falling to the ground.

Fothergilla prefers moist but well drained, acidic and cool soil. It performs best in full sun, but will live in some shade. It is slow growing and will become a dense mound. There seem to be no insect or disease problems. Robinson Nursery offers this plant as a shrub in #2 Grow Ready™ liner.
