'Allee'® is a selection of *Ulmus parvifolia*. It is DED resistant, and a very lovely tree. The exfoliating bark is wondrous, with gray, green, orange and tan colors in a jigsaw jumble. The foliage is bright green in summer and turns yellow in autumn.

'Allee'® is resistant to most insect problems, and is tolerant of urban conditions.

Most Elms transplant poorly bare root. We usually suggest 'sweating'

and also pruning back lateral branches hard. Because of the transplanting problem, Robinson Nursery now offers 'Allee'® and all our Elms in #3 containers.
