

Acer x freemanii 'Marmo'

Marmo Maple

Zone: 4-7

Height: 60'-70'

Width: 35'-40'

Crown: Upright Oval
Growth Rate: Fast
Soil: Clay, Loam, Sand
pH: Acid, some alkaline
Fruit: Seedless
Drought: Tolerant
Breakage: Resistant



Acer Marmo was selected from a group of trees planted at the Morton Arboretum in the 1920's. It is a large tree with an upright oval form. It is a vigorous grower with good branch structure and strength. Fall color is variable depending on site and weather conditions. It is more drought resistant and more alkaline soil tolerant than *Acer rubrum*. And it is seedless. Freemanii Maples tend to be almost too vigorous in the optimum conditions of the nursery, and require pruning. Once in the landscape, they slow down a little and become nearly perfect trees. Robinson Nursery offers 'Marmo' as bare root whips and branched trees.
