Exposure: Full sun

Form and Crown: Round

Growth Rate: Vigorous

Preferred pH: 6-7

Drought Tolerance: Tolerant once established

Drainage: Requires good drainage

Preferred Soil: Very adaptable

Insect Pest: Aphid, Borers

Disease Problems: Bacterial Canker, Brown Rot

Fruit Color: Dark Red

Pollinators: Rainer, Van, Republican, Sam, Stella

Productive: 3-5 years

Harvest: Late June



Bing Cherry is the most popular variety in the country.

Its dark red fruit is very sweet and juicy.

Once the fruit is ripe, it will very quickly become over ripe unless refrigerated.

Birds will compete with the grower for the fruit.

A late rain on nearly ripe fruit will split the cherry.
