

## Cornus 'Baileyi'

## Red Twig Dogwood

Zone: 2-7

Height: 8'-10'

Width: 8'-10'

Crown: Round

Growth Rate: Moderate

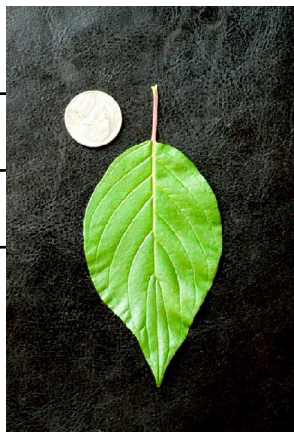
Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Acid, alkaline

Drainage: Takes wet sites

Drought: Moderate resistance

Breakage: Resistant



This is one of the Dogwoods you plant for winter color. The stems of 'Baileyi' are magnificent red all winter long. We don't have a lot of sun in Oregon in winter, but when the sun does come out, the display of this plant is dazzling. Over the years, these branches may dull and turn to brown. No problem, just whack it off at

the ground in spring and a whole glob of bright red branches will grow in their place. 'Baileyi' also has a lovely white flower in April and May and a cluster of white berries later in summer, which are cleared away by wildlife. It can be grown in full sun or part shade, on wet well drained soil. It will grow well in acid or alkaline conditions. Robinson Nursery offers Cornus 'Baileyi' in various sizes of bare root shrubs.
