## 'Arnold's Promise' Witch Hazel

Zone: 5-8

Height: 10'

Width: 8'



Crown: Upright, vase  
Uniformity: Irregular  
Growth Rate: Moderate  
Soil: Clay, loam, sand  
pH: Acidic, slightly alkaline  
Drainage: Well drained, some wet  
Drought: High tolerance  
Breakage: Resistant  
Pests: Few if any  
Disease: Few if any

'Arnold's Promise' is an introduction from Arnold Arboretum. It blooms later than other Hamamelis. One inch spidery clear yellow petals emerge from a reddish calyx. It is extremely fragrant. Fall color is yellow, orange, red, then brown and persist on the plant into the winter. The uses of Hamamelis are many, but it is best to use it where the bloom and fragrance will be noticed. A place where people pass by. Stem cuttings can be forced indoors for fragrance. Offered as bare root shrub.
