

## Hamamelis x intermedia

## 'Diana' Witch Hazel

Zone: 5-8

Height: 10'

Width: 8'

Crown: Upright, vase  
Uniformity: Irregular  
Growth Rate: Moderate  
Soil: Clay, loam, sand  
pH: Acidic, slightly alkaline  
Drainage: Well drained, some wet  
Drought: High tolerance  
Breakage: Resistant  
Pests: Few if any  
Disease: Few if any



'Diana' has copper red to red flowers issuing from a red calyx in winter. They are mildly fragrant and turn bronze in time. Fall color is yellow orange red. Old leaves turn very dark and persistence reduces effect of flowering. For the full effect of the floral display, it may be necessary to snip off the leaves. Robinson Nursery carries 'Diana' in several sizes of bare root shrub.
