

Hibiscus syriacus 'Blue Satin'

Hibiscus 'Blue Satin' is an introduction of Proven Winners®. It is without a doubt the best blue Hibiscus on the market today. As you can see here, they have deep blue petals, becoming dark purple in the center with a white staminal tube protruding upwards. Only 'Bluebird' comes close, and it's really only blue before the petals open up. Hibiscus grows in full sun or part shade and is adaptable to any soil. This is a plant that really likes the heat, and doesn't start blooming until days are long and hot. It doesn't care for drought though.
