

Hydrangea paniculata 'Pink Diamond' - Pink Diamond Hydrangea

Zone: 3-8

Height: 10'

Width: 8'

Exposure: Full sun to light shade
Crown: Pyramidal
Growth: Fast
Soil: Moist, well drained
pH: Slightly acidic
Drainage: Good drainage
Drought: Will tolerate short periods
Pests: Few
Disease: Few



Pink Diamond Hydrangea produces white, soon turning to pink, blooms from July to September. Blooms are on current seasons growth, so prune as needed. Stiff stems hold the rather large flowers with no drooping. We offer Pink Diamond Hydrangea in a tree form.
