

Maackia amurensis

Zone: 3-7

Height: 30'

Width: 20'

Crown: Round to vase
Growth Rate: Slow
Soil: Loam, clay, sand
pH: Acidic
Drainage: Well drained
Breakage: Resistant
Light: Full sun



Hardy and adaptable is what we read about this tree. Too bad it doesn't also read easy to grow into a single leader form, but, it is a member of the Legume Family and they are most difficult to grow. Maackia has a lot going for it though. Zone 3 hardiness, interesting new leaves (see above), interesting flowers and dark green foliage. It is probably best grown as a multi-stem tree, thereby avoiding the problems of training a single leader and lateral branching. Robinson Nursery offers Maackia as whips.
