

Magnolia lilifolia x M. Stellata

'Jane' Magnolia

Zone: 4-7

Height: 8'

Width: 10'

Crown: Round
Growth Rate: Moderate
Soil: Adaptable
pH: 5.6-7.5
Drainage: Well drained



The round, shrubby Magnolia x Jane produces slender tulip-like flowers in early to mid May. They are red/purple on the outside and white on the inside, and are extremely fragrant. Some years it will re-bloom in late summer. Introduced by the USDA, 'Jane' and the other Loebneri hybrids were developed to produce blooms later in the season, so blooms wouldn't be caught by late frosts. The 'Girly' Magnolias were the result. Unfortunately, Mag. lilifolia was one of the parents. It passed on to some of it's progeny its susceptibility to Powdery Mildew. Otherwise it is a vigorous care free large shrub.
