'Double Sub' Weeping Cherry

Zone: 5-8

'Double Sub' Cherry is a favorite in the landscape trade. It is well suited as a specimen plant. The pink double flowers on weeping branches are striking. The rest of the year, leaves are bright green until they turn showy yellow in fall. All cherries should be planted in full sun and loamy or sandy soil which is well drained. Too much clay or water, or too much drought will doom the tree. Once stressed it is susceptible to attack from pests and disease. Cherries are
