

## Taxodium distichum 'Falling Waters' - Weeping Baldcypress

Zone: 4-9

Height: As staked

Width: 6'

Exposure: Full sun, part shade  
Crown: Weeping  
Growth: Medium to fast  
Soil: Adaptable  
pH: Neutral to acid  
Drainage: Moist  
Drought: Some tolerance  
Pests: Few  
Disease: Few



Falling Waters is a selection of Bald Cypress, so we know it will thrive in standing water, but will survive in drought. This weeping tree will grow as high as staked. The tree is a deciduous conifer, so the soft needles fall off in fall, in a blaze of orange brown color. A fine weeping conifer for the garden.
