

## Ulmus americana 'Valley Forge'

## 'Valley Forge' Elm

Zone: 2-9

Height: 70'-90'

Width: 50'-70'

Crown: Upright vase, arching

Growth: Fast

Soil: Clay, loam, sand, urban

pH: Acid, alkaline

Drainage: Well drained, flooding

Drought: High tolerance

Disease: High resistance

Breakage: Resistant



Of the thousands of *Ulmus americana* trees screened, 'Valley Forge' has the most resistance to Dutch Elm Disease. It also has the classic form of *U. americana*: tall, ascending arching branches. This tree is also very vigorous, Reaching 30' in 12 years. And of course it has the adaptability to compacted soils and drought that make it such a fine specimen in the city situation, and it's long lived.

Plant 'Valley Forge' today and it will be enjoyed by a dozen generations. For the grower, this is an extremely vigorous tree. You will have to be proactive in you pruning and staking. If this tree gets ahead of you, forcing it into a straight single leader form may not be possible.
