Acer miyabei is native to Japan and was probably first



grown in this country in the Morton Arboretum. Chicagoland Grows® developed one of Morton's superior specimens and named it State Street®. This excellent tree is just becoming available in the trade. We think it will soon become a



standard in the landscape industry. State Street® is a moderately fast grower and has an upright oval form with a very dense crown. It is heat and drought, pollution and salt tolerant and leaf tatter resistant. The

tree has a tendency to a single leader and is easily grown. There seem to be no insect or disease problems. What will make State Street® a star in the trade is it's features: big, glossy dark green leaves; bark which is corky in youth, then fissured and finally flaky; and in old age the fluted trunk is very striking. Propagation is not easy but we are figuring it out. State Street® is now available in whips
