

Acer platanoides 'Pond' 'Emerald Lustre' Norway Maple

Emerald Lustre was selected by Bailey Nurseries for its hardiness, branching structure and vigor. Given room to grow, Emerald Lustre makes a beautiful specimen. The leaves emerge with a tint of red, then turn dark glossy green. Yellow is the fall color, but as you can see here, there is definitely some red involved. Being a round tree, Emerald Lustre may need to have its central leader staked. The branching is said to be prolific, so thinning may also be necessary. Aphids may be a mild problem in some areas, and as with all maples, Verticillium is a threat. Robinson Nursery offers Emerald Lustre in whips and branched tree form.
