

Acer platanoides 'Princeton Gold' 'Princeton Gold' Norway Maple

Zone: 4-8

Height: 50'

In the spring, when it first leafs out, *Acer platanoides* 'Princeton Gold' simply glows. After a long gray winter, it is a welcome sight. In warmer climates, the leaves may sunburn, but in the north, it should hold out all summer fairly well. Fall color is yellow with orange highlights and quite showy. *A. platanoides* has a tendency to sun scald when not in an irrigated situation. Wrapping the trunk helps. 'Princeton Gold' has good branching angles so breakage should not be a problem. Robinson Nursery offers 'Princeton Gold' in branched trees and whips.
