

Acer saccharum 'Endowment' 'Endowment' Sugar Maple

Zone: 3-8

Height: 50'

Width: 15'

Crown: Upright Columnar

Growth Rate: Moderate

Light: Sun or part shade

Soils: Adaptable, but not to standing water or salt

Fall Color: Red, Yellow



Here we have a very columnar form of Sugar Maple which is also very hardy. For an upright tree the branches have a good attachment angle and seldom fail. The roots of Endowment are usually fairly shallow, so some summer irrigation will keep the tree from stressing. It is adaptable to a range of soils but compacted soil will always be a problem.

The fall color of Endowment will vary depending on latitude. In it's southern range, yellow will dominate, while in the north, red will be predominate.

It is Verticillium susceptible but there seem to be few if any other problems.

So here you have an upright, hardy tree with good fall color. Exactly what everyone wants. Robinson grows this tree in branched and light branched forms as well as whips.
