

Amelanchier x grandiflora

'Autumn Brilliance'® Serviceberry

Zone: 4-8

Height: 20'

Width: 15'

Crown: Upright vase

'Autumn Brilliance' is a cross between *Am. canadensis* and *Am. laevis*. The hybrid is the most 'asked for' Amelanchier. It is more resistant to disease than either parent. It is more adaptable to different soils. It forms a very dense canopy which is good for birds and is covered in spring with amazing white blooms. Summer foliage is glossy and dark green. In late summer the berries become black and are edible, also a boon to birds.

Best of all, the bright red/orange/yellow fall color of 'Autumn Brilliance' is exceptional. In some areas with very wet, warm springs, fungal or rust diseases may be a problem.

In some areas insects can be a problem. But this is such a talented small tree that you should give it a try. Robinson Nursery offers 'Autumn Brilliance' in branched, whips and multi-stem trees.
