

Amelanchier x grandiflora

'Robin Hill' Serviceberry

Zone: 4a-7b

Height: 20'-30'

Width: 12'-15'

Crown: Upright, irregular

Growth Rate: Moderate

Soil: Clay, Loam, Sand

pH: Acidic

Salt: Moderate tolerance

Drought: Not tolerant



'Robin Hill' is an upright growing tree that is still tall enough to fit below utility lines. It will go perfectly in parking strips and not heave sidewalks in 30 or 40 years. It offers a splendid floral display in early spring; clean, bright summer foliage; berries for humans or birds in late summer; and brilliant orange red fall colors. As with all the amelanchiers, it will have some disease or insect problems in certain areas. It will probably be happier in an area with a dry spring. This cultivar is said to sucker less than its parents and grows easily into a tree form. Robinson Nursery offers 'Robin Hill' as branched and whip trees.
