



We have been developing a tree hydrangea program for a good many years. One of the problems we have had was developing a canopy at a consistent height. Thanks to a neighbor, we are now using a plastic tube early in the season. The plants respond by pushing growth straight up. So much so that we can now guarantee a 30" branching height. The early growth also means more caliper.

We are offering **PeeGee** ('Grandiflora'), 'Kyushu', 'Limelight', 'Pink Diamond', **Quickfire** ® and 'Tardiva'. Sales of tree hydrangea have been strong, but we still have some numbers available.

Another tree form we have been developing for many years is the grafted standard program. We started with ornamental apples, and soon moved on to other plants. Probably the most challenging were the Syringa varieties. We overcame this challenge by using a whip and tongue graft which produces a balanced canopy.
