



The plants are out of the ground!

We are wrapping up our harvest season at Robinson Nursery. The plants are out of the ground and stored in our state of the art storage facilities. We use two methods of storage at Robinson Nursery. We store plants in heel-in-beds and humidity controlled cold storage. Certain plants perform better in different storage conditions. We store plants based on what is best for the plants.

Plants that break dormancy early in the season are placed directly into the cooler to maintain dormancy and minimize handling (Pyrus, Prunus, Malus, Syringa, Gleditsia). The plants are stored on racks with their roots pointing out so that they may be watered easily. The cooler is run at 35 degrees while a MicroMist misting system maintains a high level of humidity. We are able to run Zerotel through the mist system to help eliminate pesky problems like botrytis. These optimum storage conditions help to minimize desiccation of the plant material. The more water retention the plants have the better they will perform out of the gate.

Plants that break dormancy late in the season are placed into sawdust heel-in-beds (Acer, Fraxinus, Quercus, Hydrangea, Cornus). This is a great method of storage. The root systems of the plants are able to callus and grow new roots while they are stored. Throughout the year we water our tiled sawdust beds to help minimize desiccation of the plant material. The moisture levels in the beds are very important. Not enough water and the plants can dry out; too much water and the plants can have fungal issues. The plants that remain in the beds are brought into the cooler prior to breaking dormancy. At Robinson Nursery we believe it is very important to ship dormant bareroot plants to our customers.



We are constantly improving the way we store plants. Our goal is to always do what is best for the plants so that they are at peak performance for you.
