

## Acer campestre

Zone: 5a

Height: 30'-40'

Width: 30'-40'



Exposure: Full sun

Crown: Round

Growth: Slow

pH: Neutral to alkaline, does well in Oregon's acid soil

Drainage: Prefers good drainage

Drought: Very tolerant

Pests: Minor-gall blights and aphids

Disease: Verticillium wilt

Hedge maple is an urban tough tree that should be used more often. It is very drought tolerant and will grow in poor soils. It sets a moderate sized green leaf that turns yellow in fall. It also sets large quantities of large samaras, varying tree to tree in color from tan to orange red. The bark is corky with age. All in all, a good performer.
